**Electrical Contractor Licenses expire each year on April 30th.**

The electrical code of the Village of River Hills requires that:

The electrical inspector must be notified when the supervising electrician terminates or changes his/her status with an employer

All newly installed electrical services must be of the underground type.

Garbage disposal installations must be done by switched receptacle and cord and plug connections.

Double fees will be charged for any work started before obtaining a permit.

The permit application form states that the permit will be voided if no work is started within two month, or if started, no work is done for two months. The village hall must be notified of any change in the status of work.

Permit fees are non-refundable.
